



SUBJECT: Road Closure and Disposition - Seylynn Developments

#### RECOMMENDATION:

#### THAT:

- Mountain Highway and Fern Street Highway Closure Bylaw 7953, 2012 is given First Reading; and,
- Staff be directed to publish the required notice of intention to close, removal of dedication and subsequent disposal of the newly created lots.

#### REASON FOR REPORT:

Mountain Highway and Fern Street Highway Closure Bylaw 7953, 2012 (Attachment 2) authorizes the closure and the raising of title to portions of Mountain Highway, Fern Street and the remainder of an opened lane allowance, for the purpose of consolidation with the adjacent development property. (Attachment 1)

#### SUMMARY:

The District has negotiated a complex agreement with Seylynn (North Shore) Properties Corp. ("Seylynn") in which the District will transfer portions of road, the remainder of a lane allowance and a fee simple property to Seylynn in exchange for a portion of their development property to accommodate a new road dedication for the purpose of constructing and extending Keith Road.

Prior to completing the transaction contemplated in the above agreement, the District must stop up, close, and raise title to the road and lane allowance concurrently with the Planning Department process regarding the rezoning the property. The transfer of the roads is contingent upon adoption of the rezoning bylaw.

#### ANALYSIS:

The stopping up and closing of those portions of road and lane allowance adjacent to the Seylynn property is required to accommodate the dedication and construction of the new Keith Rd extension. Due to this new road alignment, the Seylynn development requires portions of Mountain Highway and Fern St.

#### Process/Public Input:

In accordance with the provisions of Section 26 and Section 94 of the *Community Charter* a notice of Council's intention to adopt this bylaw and exchange the road and lane allowances must be published in a local newspaper once a week for two consecutive weeks. Council must then provide an opportunity for persons who consider they are affected by the bylaw to make representations to Council.

Utility Companies must be provided notice and the opportunity to provide submissions regarding the proposed road closure.

#### Concurrence:

Planning, Engineering and Transportation have concurred to the proposed plan.

#### Financial Impacts:

Seylynn is responsible for all associated costs of the road and lane closures.

#### Liability/Risk:

Seylynn will own portions of Mountain Highway and Fern St. prior to the construction of the Keith Road extension. To negate any liability and/or risk, the District will secure a Statutory Right Of Way ("SRW") over these portions so that there will be no disruption of traffic until such time Fern St is closed and the traffic diverted to the new Keith Rd extension. The SRW's will then be discharged so the developer then may use the lands in conjunction with the proposed development. Portions of the SRW's adjacent to the road allowance will remain for public works. The SRW's will contain the necessary and appropriate indemnities from Seylynn in favour of the District.

#### Options:

- That Council give the proposed bylaw First Reading as well as direct staff to publish notice in a newspaper of the proposed road closure and exchange in accordance with requirements of the Community Charter (staff recommendation);
- That Council not give the proposed bylaw First Reading and do not authorize staff to publish notice in a newspaper of the proposed road closure and exchange in accordance with requirements of the Community Charter.



#### The Corporation of the District of North Vancouver

#### **Bylaw 7953**

A bylaw to close and remove highway dedication

WHEREAS under the Community Charter the Council may close to traffic and remove the dedication of a highway; and,

WHEREAS the Council has posted and published notices of its intention to close the highway referred to in this Bylaw and remove its dedication, and has provided an opportunity for persons who consider they are affected to make representations to the Council; and,

WHEREAS the Council does not consider that the closure will affect the transmission or distribution facilities or works of utility operators;

The Council for The Corporation of the District of North Vancouver enacts as follows:

#### 1. Citation

This bylaw may be cited as "Mountain Highway and Fern Street Highway Closure Bylaw 7953, 2012".

#### 2. Bylaw to close and remove highway dedication

- 2.1 The portions of highway dedicated by Plans 3881, 9135, BCP45273 and BCP11973 shown as "CLOSED LANE" and "CLOSED ROAD" on the Reference Plan, a reduced copy of which is attached to this bylaw as Schedule A, is closed to all types of traffic.
- 2.2 The dedication as a highway of the "CLOSED LANE" and "CLOSED ROAD" is removed.
- 2.3 The Mayor and Clerk are authorized to execute and delivered such transfers, deeds of land, plans and other documents as are required to effect the aforesaid closure and removal of highway dedication.




