

SUBJECT: Results of Election by Voting - 2014 General Local Election

RECOMMENDATION:

THAT the report from the Chief Election Officer dated November 18, 2014 regarding Results of Election by Voting – 2014 General Local Election be received for information.

REASON FOR REPORT:

Section 148 of the *Local Government Act* requires the Chief Election Officer to report the results of election by voting to the local government within thirty days of the declaration of official results.

ANALYSIS:

General voting day took place on November 15, 2014 with advance polls held on November 5, 6, 8 and 10. New this year was the advance poll on November 6 held at Capilano University. Despite it being heavily promoted, turnout was only 39 voters. Overall advance voter turnout was 753.

A special voting opportunity was held for patients at Lions Gate Hospital. Mail-in ballots were available for six long-term care facilities (two being added in 2014) as well as for eligible voters who would not be available on any of the five voting days.

Overall voter turnout was 14,709 of 59,617 eligible voters (24.67%).



SUBJECT: Appointment of GVRD Director and Acting Mayor for December

RECOMMENDATION:

THAT Mayor Walton is appointed as the Municipal Director to the Greater Vancouver Regional District Board and that Councillor _____ is appointed as the alternate.

THAT Councillor Muri is appointed as Acting Mayor for the period December 5, 2014 to January 4, 2015.

REASON FOR REPORT:

To appoint a Director and alternate to the Greater Vancouver Regional District Board in advance of the Board's December 12 inaugural meeting as well appointing an Acting Mayor for December as Council will not be discussing this matter in full until December 8.

BACKGROUND:

Council must appoint a Director and alternate to the Greater Vancouver Regional District Board following each general local election for a term not to exceed the period between general elections or at such time as the Council wishes to appoint a different Director or alternate. This must be done very early in the term of a new council in order to have a Director appointed in time for the Board's inaugural meeting which occurs shortly after those of the municipal councils who are GVRD members. The 2014 GVRD inaugural meeting is December 12.

Also, Council must establish an annual schedule of Councillors to act in the place of the Mayor when absent. Council plans to discuss this matter on December 8. Councillor Hicks's term as Acting Mayor expires on December 4. In order to have an Acting Mayor with full lawful authority in the interim, an appointment by resolution will be necessary.

OPTIONS:

With respect to the appointment of the GVRD Director and alternate:

- 1. Council may appoint the Mayor as Director and Councillor _____ as the alternate; or,
- 2. Council may appoint any other member of Council as either Director or alternate.

Page 2

With respect to the appointment of an Acting Mayor:

- 1. Council may appoint Councillor Muri as Acting Mayor for a thirty day period; or,
- 2. Council may appoint Councillor Muri as Acting Mayor for a shorter period; or
- 3. Council may appoint any other Councillor as Acting Mayor for a period they feel is appropriate.
