Title:	DISPOSITION OF SURPLUS ROAD ALLOWANCE	1

## POLICY

**RECOGNISING** that the alternatives available for the disposition of surplus road allowance within the District are:

- 1. Plans Cancellation pursuant to Part 8 of the Land Title Act
- 2. Highway Abandonment under Section 524 of the Local Government Act
- 3. Highway Exchange under Section 525 of the Local Government Act
- 4. Replotting pursuant to P.28 of Division 2 of the Local Government Act.

AND RECOGNISING the high value of land and the resulting scarcity of living accommodation;

The District will consider assisting property owners in securing the best development of their property where there is the relocation of a highway or the disposal of unneeded road allowance is involved;

#### PROVIDED THAT:

- 1. the resulting developments comply fully with Council policy as expressed in their various bylaws;
- 2. the speediest and least expensive method to achieve the end is utilized;
- 3. fair and reasonable payment based on market evidence for the relinquishment of the District's right of possession is secured, and
- 4. the surplus road allowance is in an unopened street or lane.

## **REASON FOR POLICY**

To ensure that the District is adequately compensated for disposing of surplus road allowance when such road allowances are required to provide optimum land development potential.
