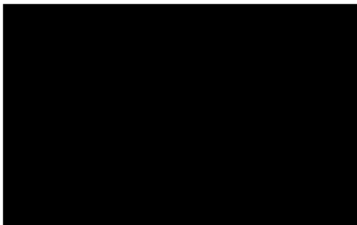

Good evening, Mayor Walton and members of Council,

My name is Eric Andersen and I live at [REDACTED] and tonight I am speaking as the co-chair of the BCA.

DNV staff brought to our attention that the owner of 2698 Violet Street in Seymour Heights has applied to subdivide his property into two small lots.

We sent this information out to the about 300 households that are on our e-mail list, but we never received any response in this respect - negative or positive.
