	DISTRICT FIRE HALLS AND FIRE TRAINING CENTRES	

POLICY

The District of North Vancouver will liaise with the community to provide the opportunity for public consultation and input prior to:

- a proposal for a major renovation affecting the exterior of a fire hall or fire training centre; or
- new construction of a fire hall or fire training centre;

being submitted for building permit approval.

To facilitate early dialogue, proposals will be forwarded to the affected registered community association and affected neighbouring properties early in the design review process. This consultation may be followed by a public information meeting.

Prior to any Public Information Meeting being held, Council will be notified of the date and time of the meeting and provided with information on the proposal.

Following the consultation process a summary of the community input will be provided to Council.

REASON FOR POLICY

- 1. To establish early dialogue with community.
- 2. To expand the opportunities for public consultation.
- 3. To ensure that factual information on all aspects of the proposal is conveyed to the affected community.
- 4. To enable staff and Council to gauge public opinion on a particular proposal.
