## POLICY

On-duty Fire and Rescue staff who encounter an emergency incident located outside of their normally approved response jurisdiction are authorized to render reasonable aid or assistance consistent with their approved training and equipment. The cost of the provision of such aid may be billed back to the recipient of the assistance.

## **REASON FOR POLICY**

To authorize on-duty Fire and Rescue Services to lend emergency assistance outside of their normally approved response jurisdiction
