# Seeking Municipal Endorsement

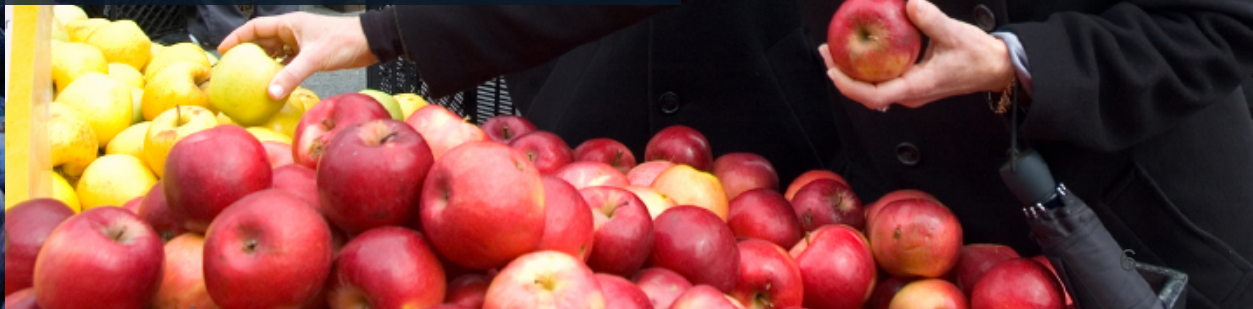
1. Endorse Action Plan in principle;
