# **Key Financial Policies**

- Growth management
  - stabilization, reserve tax growth for future service impacts, investing in safe and active transportation
- Revenue
  - Fees keeping pace with rising costs
  - tax @ 2% inflation + 1% asset renewal
- Surplus
  - supports one-time items eg: transportation and policy planning initiatives



### Key Focus Areas in Plan

- Construction management strategies & parking policy in town centres
- Updating childcare policy
- Safety, enforcement and active transportation
- Non-market housing initiatives
- Work with Senior Govt. and Translink on a range of key transportation improvements



## **Strategic Priorities**

- Lions Gate Community Centre construction
- Seylynn and Lynn Canyon Park improvements
- Artificial turf fields at Inter River and Argyle School
- Maplewood Fire Hall (complete design)
- Enhanced parking and traffic management in key recreational areas
- Lions Gate Waste Water Treatment Plant
- DCC plan refresh



# **2018 Capital Budget Highlights**

- Asset Renewal Programs = \$35M
- Upgrades/Expansion = \$31M
  - Lions Gate Community Centre \$14M
  - Maplewood Fire Facility \$1.3M
  - Non-market Housing \$1.8M
  - Debris and wild fire management \$1.6M
  - Sportsfields \$2.1M
  - Urban park renewal / upgrades \$3.1M
  - Active Transportation/Safety \$2.1M
