*Recommendation*: THAT Council resolve that:

1. Council considers the accumulated materials and derelict vehicles in the front yard, carport, back yard, side yards and under the deck of the property at 4592 Ramsay Road, legally described as:

PIO: 009-063-935 Lot K of Block 23 District Lot 2088 PLAN 11452

(the "Property")

are so unsightly and unclean as to be offensive to the community and declares, that the accumulated materials, parts, equipment, derelict vehicles, trailers, camper and untidy growths constitute a nuisance. The accumulated materials include (without limitation):

- (a) the accumulated materials, parts, equipment, derelict vehicles and trailers, camper and untidy growths shown in the photographs attached as Attachment A to the Council Report prepared by the Bylaw Enforcement Officer and dated October 7, 2020 (collectively, the "Accumulated Materials and Derelict Vehicles'); and,
- (b) the deteriorating structure in the rear yard (the "Accessory Building").
- 2. Pursuant to section 72(2)(b)(i) of the *Community Charter,* Council orders that Richard L. Band, the registered owner of the Property (the "Owner"), must:
  - (a) completely remove the Accumulated Materials and Derelict Vehicles from the Property; and,
  - (b) demolish the Accessory Building or bring it into compliance with the Construction Bylaw 8271 by installing siding,

to the satisfaction of the Chief Bylaw Officer by November 20, 2020

("the Remedial Action Requirement")

- 3. In the event that the Owner fails to fully comply with the Remedial Action Requirement by November 20, 2020:
  - (a) the District, by its staff, agents and contractors, may enter onto the Property and take all the necessary actions to fulfil the Remedial Action Requirement at the expense of the Owner in accordance with section 17 of the *Community Charter;* and,
  - (b) the costs of such actions shall be a debt owed to the District of North Vancouver which, if unpaid at the end of the calendar year, will be added to the Property taxes for the next calendar year, pursuant to s. 258 of the *Community Charter.*

- (b) Require all Part 3 Residential new construction to meet Step 4 or Step 3 with a Low Carbon Energy System (LCES);
- (c) Require all Part 3 Commercial new construction to meet Step 3 or Step 2 with a Low Carbon Energy System (LCES);
- (d) Require significant renovations to Part 3 Commercial buildings to meet Step 1 of the BC Energy Step Code;
- (e) Require all Public Sector Buildings including new construction to meet Step 1 of the BC Energy Step Code.
