Three components to the update:

Change to Procedures Bylaw

- Bylaw details the statutory requirement for Public Hearing signs, including the number of signs, size, location, and content as shown in the sign template attached to the bylaw
- New requirement for all signs to be bidirectional signs viewable from both directions on a street and a new option for additional signs as required for projects near arterials

Update to Fee Bylaw


• To reflect costs to the District to produce and install the required bi-directional signs for both statutory and non-statutory notification.

Update to existing corporate policy on non-statutory public consultation

- Sign details added to match the proposed Statutory notification requirements in the Procedures Bylaw
- Specifies quantity, location, size and content of notification signs, where required, to match that of the statutory Public Hearing signs
