I would like to express my concerns regarding traffic and parking issues with the increase in the capacity at the daycare.

and have lived here for over 25 yrs.

Iam very familiar with the comings and goings of these child centers.

Iam also the resident that petitioned DNV for the Crosswalk at E13th & Gladstone.

Iam also the resident that witnessed and responded first to the child who was hit by a car on E13th which was directly related to illegal parking that blocked the visibility of the crosswalk.

Iam the parent that petitioned the school to have 5e parking restricted in the lane behind sunshine preschool as well as install signs and barriers to actually prevent parking, not just a painted yellow curb, which is ignored.

Iam very invested in the traffic in my neighbourhood and the school.

The parking and the flow of traffic in the last block of E13th, into the culdesac, in/out of the lanes inside the culdesac, as well as the 2 parking lots is absolutely horrendous and can not accomodate any more vehicles. Adding 10 families + 2 staff is a .....40 car trips a day minimum into a very chaotic congested zone. The daycare sits right on the edge of this culdesac and south lane.

I have 2 concerns

The lane south of e13th back of applicants property needs to have traffic calming barriers installed. This lane is used as a circle route and the volume and speed of the parents (because they are all late), has reached an unacceptable level.

There is not adaquate parking anywhere for the 3 childcare centers and every day we have illegal parking in the lane including blocking the front of my garage

The tiny parking lot of 12 spaces in inadaquate. The 5 preschool staff and FF 4 staff and any visitors to school park here. It is always full. Daycare parents will have no where to drop off, and mahem will continue

I oppose the increase in daycare capacity unless permanent traffic calming is installed in the south lane and a designated drop off zone in front of the daycare is provided. We have not ever seen the large gate in the back of the property open for daycare families or staff.

I feel the business should contribute to the traffic calming barriers as a sincere intention of keeping the neighbourhood safe and respecting their other neighbours.






